

Egg freezing packages

1 cycle

1900 €

3 cycles (save 1100 €)

4 600 €

Price includes:

Monitoring, ultrasound scans, and consultations with doctors

Sexually transmitted disease testing (Hepatitis B and C, HIV, and syphilis)

Pre-operative blood tests

Egg retrieval performed under general anaesthesia

Vitrification of up to 3 straws (1 straw = max 2 oocytes) +1 year of storage

Deposit for the Egg freezing package: €1,000

Not included in the price:

- ECG (for women over 40): €100
- Stimulation medications: €600–€1,200
- Each year of cryostorage beyond the 1 included: €200
- Each straw in addition to the 3 included: €100
- Thawing of oocytes + semen analysis + STD testing + ICSI + prolonged cultivation + embryo transfer: €1,200


Administration Fee

In the event of a cancelled cycle, an administration fee of €300 applies.

This fee is always non-refundable and does not cover the cost of tests.

Refunds

Once stimulation has started (medications taken) and the egg retrieval stage is not reached, the €1,000 deposit is non-refundable. All medication purchases are non-refundable.



How long will you be in Prague?

Please plan to stay in Prague for about 4 days. We warmly recommend joining us already for your first stimulation scan, as it ensures the most accurate monitoring and smoothest treatment process.

Consultations and pre-treatment tests are completely free of charge.

What will be required before treatment?

- Signed informed consent forms
- STD test results (HIV, hepatitis B/C, syphilis)
- Pelvic ultrasound with a clear image of the uterus and fallopian tubes
- Fertility blood test to check levels of hormones FSH, LH, AMH, PRL, TSH and E2 should be performed between 2nd and 5th day of menstruation
- PAP test

If over 40: Breast examination (external provider)

Recommended: ureaplasma, mycoplasma, chlamydia smear test

We'll provide a checklist and help arrange any tests needed.



The truth about social freezing

Egg freezing can be a great option – but it's not for everyone. Studies show that up to 92% of women never use their frozen eggs, either because they conceive naturally or decide not to have children. The best time is usually between 32–35, if you know you want a family, but don't have the right partner yet. Remember: freezing eggs is not a guarantee of a baby, as the uterus also ages and pregnancy risks rise after 40. We believe in honest guidance – let's talk openly about your options.
